OPTIONS TO RESCHEDULE

- If your group would like, you can reschedule the trip. All payments received, less any non-recoverable deposits, will be fully applied to the rescheduled trip.

OPTIONS TO CANCEL FOR REFUNDS

- If your group would like, you can cancel the trip. All payments received, less any non-recoverable deposits and \$200 per person booking fee will immediately be refunded.

CANCEL FOR ANY REASON (CFAR) INSURANCE PROTECTION

- We suggest purchasing CFAR Insurance with the tour package. This insurance will provide refunds if an individual decides to cancel from a scheduled trip or if the group decides to cancel or reschedule the trip.

CFAR Insurance reimburses 100% of financial loss for cancellations due to emergency reasons such as sickness or injury, death, jury duty, military personnel called to emergency duty for a disaster other than war, etc.

a CFAR Insurance reimburses 75% of financial loss for cancellations due to nonemergency reasons.
